



The Music House 155 GATE ST, NOTL

This warm family home is filled with the history of music, gatherings and celebration. Built in 1823, this was the original Methodist Meeting House, originally located at Gage and Gate Streets. Today the new owners, Eric and Laura, are honouring its historic connection with their own 'music room', complete with a grand piano, a harpsichord, a vintage glass harmonica, and a 1615 Viola de Gamba — with an ear to what those early Methodists might have been hearing at their weekly meetings. You will be greeted not only with the warmth of an original stone fireplace, ivorypainted pine floors, and the grace of a comforting and unusually expansive stairwell, but also with the music of the past, and the haunting strings of a beautiful 'Viol', courtesy of owners Eric and Laura.

Rhonda Holloway of Help Me Rhonda's Interiors & Faye McAlpine of FMC Designs have collaborated once again, to present an elegant and sophisticated holiday version of this beautiful home. The historical features of each room are showcased in soft colors, glittering greenery, and an abundance of lights.

King's Landing 289 RICARDO ST, NOTL

PRESENTED BY: PENINSULA FLOORING LTD.

This historic home is all about history and location, offering stunning views of the Niagara River, Fort Niagara, and Fort George. Built in 1908 by John J. Wright — a contemporary of Tesla and Edison — it was named King's Landing and once served as the docking site for his steam yacht, Electra. Today, guests are welcomed by a 115-year-old Wisteria vine, an original 1904 outdoor dining shed, and a handsome Tudor Revival home. The main entrance opens to classic Arts and Crafts architecture, featuring rich wood trim, a three-story staircase with carved newel posts and balustrades, and other original period details. A ghostly figure has even been spotted on the stairs. The living room's heritage fireplace is featured in Trisha Romance's, Christmas at the Cottage. A recent two-storey rear addition was constructed using original stone recovered on the property, resulting in a seamless and authentic addition to this beautifully preserved home.

Brockamour Manor 433 KING ST, NOTL

PRESENTED BY: THE GOETTLER FAMILY FOUNDATION

The love begins as soon as you walk through the landscaped gardens, past the period-perfect holly and ivy, and enter the lobby. Built in 1809 by John Powell, District of Niagara Registrar, it was destroyed in the 1813 fire, leaving only the kitchen wing partially untouched. In 1818, Powell rebuilt the home in the Regency style you see today, with stuccoed brick, stunning oversized windows, and a rare elliptical fanlight above the side entry. The love continues with owners Diki and Alex, who carefully preserve its detailed interior fixtures, original crown mouldings and hardwood floors, tigerwood banisters, metallic sheen wallpaper, and distinctive heritage décor in each of their six guest rooms. But the 'romantic' history always captures their guests imagination. Powell's sister-in-law, Miss Sophia Shaw, was the love of General Isaac Brock, and it was here that Brock reputedly said farewell to Miss Sophia before his tragic march up Queenston Heights.

Garden Club of Niagara: A colourful mix of fresh and dried florals with lush greenery in period designs will complement the glory of this historic manor B&B upstairs and down. A young Sophia dressed in floral couture will be present mourning her lost love, General Brock.

The Beacon Hill 686 CHARLOTTE ST, NOTL

This 1980s Cape Cod two-storey home will delight and surprise you with astonishing renovations by its owners, Betty and Kent, who blended the old with the new, resulting in an ageless design. The dramatic 'great room' features a soaring 17 ft ceiling, with a magnificent floor to ceiling matte black, wood-trimmed fireplace, and panoramic views of the surrounding nature. Bold artworks complement the ever-changing scenery, with favourites from artist, Bev Aldridge. Elegant lighting, such as a stunning tubular chandelier, adds a touch of drama to this exceptional space. The chef's kitchen is ideal for many inspired meals, with a traditional dining room that offers legacy, comfort, and originality – in a home that doesn't stop surprising. Note the cleverly crafted embossed, wood-panelled stairwell, and do not miss the smallest room in the house – an art deco inspired powder room.

ANNUAL SITE NOTL: DECORATED BY DEDICATED VOLUNTEERS Grace United Church 222 VICTORIA ST.



Circa 1852, William Thomas, a renowned British architect designed this Romanesquestyle church, one of only three of his smaller churches still in existence. He designed over one hundred buildings in Canada including ornate churches such as St. Michael's Cathedral in Toronto as well as many civic buildings across the country. The Courthouse on Queen Street and Brock's Monument in Queenston are other examples of his work.

WOODBOURNE INN 214 FOUR MILE CREEK RD, ST DAVIDS PRESENTED BY: ST DAVID'S VETERINARY CLINIC

Perhaps it's the magical secrets you discover when you visit the historic Woodbourne Inn that make it so compelling. From its magnificent pocket sliding doors, to hidden staircases and alcoves, and surprising twists and turns, the inn is a wonderful mystery. Built in 1839 by William Woodruff, a prominent and influential Loyalist, his simple Georgian home doubled in size as his fortunes grew. By century's end it had its characteristic mix of Georgian/Victorian architecture. Intricate details are carefully preserved, from its sculptured ceiling rosettes to elaborate marbleized mantels. The shining feature in the original ballroom is an 1860s rosewood Dunham and Sons Square Grand Piano — rare and beautiful. Today, the owners focus on sustainability, ensuring everything is upcycled, antique or vintage. Enjoy the warmth of an 1839 Rumford fireplace, an eclectic library from Bradbury to Shaw, and in the gardens, a breathtaking cathedral spread of white pine.



ANNUAL SITE NOTL: DECORATED BY THE GARDEN CLUB OF NIAGARA

McFarland House 15927 NIAGARA PARKWAY

The Garden Club of Niagara will decorate in the theme, 'Two Hundred Years of McFarland Christmas'. Walking through the garden into the ground floor you will experience Christmas décor circa 1825. On the second floor, the period is 1925, and back downstairs, enjoy coffee and goodies in the Conservatory with decor from 2025.

This historic Georgian manor home was built by John McFarland and his sons. Descendants of the McFarlands lived in the house for over 140 years before it was restored by The Niagara Parks Commission and opened to the public in 1959. During the War of 1812, both British and American



forces used the home as a hospital, and in 1813, the British attack on Fort Niagara was launched from the ravine on the property. McFarland House is one of the only structures to survive the burning of the town when occupying American forces retreated from the area, making it one of the oldest properties in Niagara-on-the-Lake. Today, McFarland House portrays early nine-teenth century life in Upper Canada. There will be sticky toffee pudding, scones, homemade hot chocolate, mulled cider, and tea. www.mcfarlandhouse.com

ANNUAL SITE QUEENSTON: DECORATED BY MULLEN GARDEN MARKET RiverBrink Art Museum 116 QUEENSTON ST

RiverBrink Art Museum is home to historical artworks created by Canadian, American, and European artists from the collection of the late Samuel E. Weir. Artworks by many of Canada's most celebrated artists, including Tom Thomson and members of the Group of Seven, are on display. During the Holiday House Tour, RiverBrink is showcasing the collection in exhibitions: Centre & Periphery: The Group of Seven; Under One Roof: Family in Art; and Mapping the Land, along with contemporary exhibition, Passages: Darren Booth.



This year, Mullen Garden Market brings a festive touch to the art museum with amazing holiday displays and decorations. Visitors are welcome to enjoy festive tea in the Studio Gallery and shop in the RiverBrink Boutique, which features local artwork for purchase, as well as the beautiful grounds overlooking the Niagara River.




