Originally built by Dr. James Muirhead, widely recognized as Niagara's pioneer physician, the home was destroyed during the fire of 1813 and thoughtfully rebuilt by Muirhead in 1817. Today, the elegant residence operates as a successful Inn, where careful renovations have preserved its historic integrity through original windows, antique mantels, and enduring architectural details. Beyond its storied past lies a striking great room, where owner Phil has artfully layered bold contemporary design over a foundation of timeless elegance. Gilt mirrors, antique sconces, richly carved furnishings, curated artwork, and distinctive zebra-print accents reflect a passion for fine antiques, global influences, and exceptional craftsmanship, creating a home that beautifully bridges two centuries of Niagara history.

The Kirby House 130 FRONT ST, NOTL

The Kirby House, named for its most prominent former homeowner, William Kirby, is a true gem in the local historic landscape. Recognized by the Archaeological Society of Ontario and designated a Historic Site, the 1818 Georgian home is admired by those who pause to read the plaque out front and wonder what lies within. Current homeowners David and Dinah are proud to be part of its remarkable history, joining a distinguished lineage of residents that includes Betty Lane, a prominent painter of Niagara scenes who lived here in the 1940s. The home's historical significance lies not only in its notable residents, but also in its beautifully preserved architectural details. Impeccably restored fire-place mantels take centre stage among heritage furnishings and storied mementos. Low ceilings, traditional windows and trim evoke another era, while thoughtful modern touches respect the home's historical integrity. At Christmas, The Kirby House becomes truly magical—a place where stepping inside feels like stepping back in time.

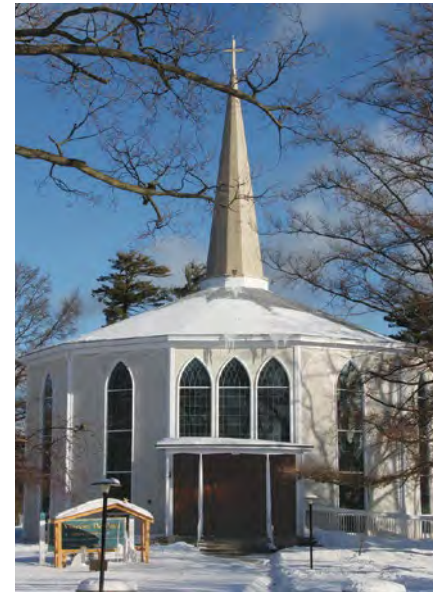
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7. ANNUAL SITE NOTL: DECORATED BY DEDICATED VOLUNTEERS St. Vincent de Paul Church 73 PICTON ST.



The Parish was established in 1826. In 1834, the Roman Catholic community built a clapboard church on land granted by the Crown.

The present day church is on the original site. All future renovations remained consistent with the original Gothic Revival style. The large addition, constructed in 1964, preserved most of the older section of the church with the choir loft serving as a bridge between the old and new. St. Vincent de Paul is the oldest Catholic church in continuous use in the Province of Ontario.

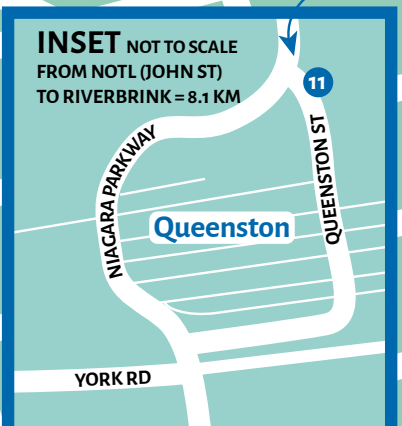
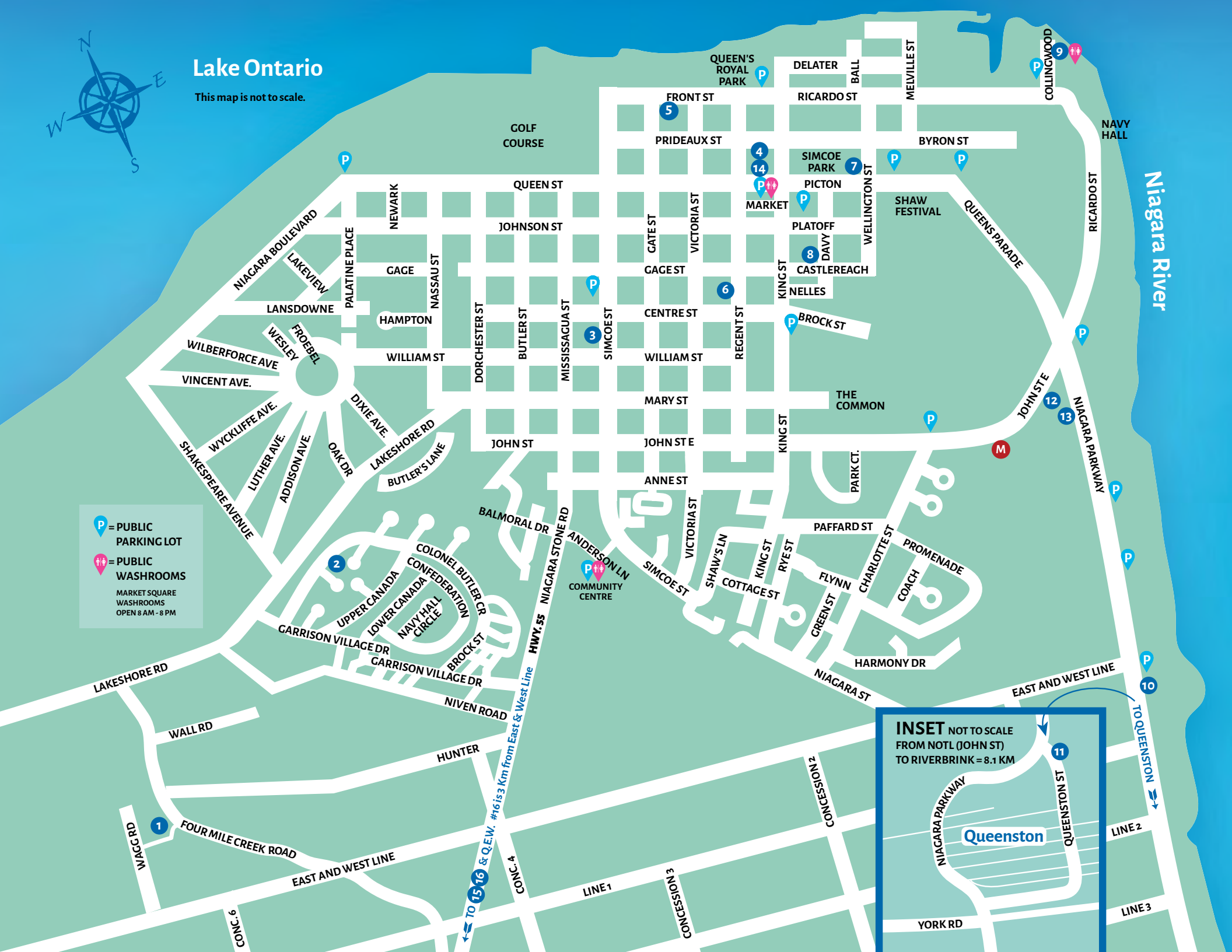




Lake Ontario

McFarland House 15927 NIAGARA PARKWAY

To celebrate its 30th Anniversary, The Garden Club of Niagara will be decorating: 'A Festive Celebration of Art Through the Ages'. While in the garden, reflect on the art style of famed Ojibway artist, Norval Morrisseau. Inside the home, experience a variety of unique designs, each inspired by a notable work of art. Finish your tour in the warmth of the Conservatory, filled with original works of art & refreshments.

This historic Georgian manor home was built by John McFarland and his sons. Descendants of the McFarlands lived in the house for over 140 years before it was restored by The Niagara Parks Commission and opened to the public in 1959. During the War of 1812, both British and American forces used the home as a hospital, and in 1813, the British attack on Fort Niagara was launched from the ravine on the property. McFarland House is one of the only structures to survive the burning of the town when occupying American forces retreated from the area, making it one of the oldest properties in Niagara-on-the-Lake. Today, McFarland House portrays early nineteenth century life in Upper Canada. **There will be sticky toffee pudding, scones, homemade hot chocolate, mulled cider, and tea.** www.mcfarlandhouse.com

RiverBrink Art Museum is home to an important collection of historical art-works created by Canadian, American, and European artists, from the collection of the late Samuel E. Weir. Art works by many of Canada's most celebrated artists, including Tom Thomson and members of the Group of Seven, are on display. During the Holiday House Tour, RiverBrink is showcasing the collection in the exhibitions: **Centre & Periphery: The Group of Seven, The Mighty Sea; and Look at Me: Portraits from the Collection.**
